Summer Hockey Opportunity

We have a number of budding young hockey players in our school who are always keen for further opportunities to play the game. The advert below outlines the summer hockey competition that is available.

We will be running the after school hockey competition in Term 4, at the Dudley Park Multi-Sport turf and the Waimakariri Hockey Turf in Rangiora.

The competition will run for 6 weeks, beginning Tuesday 31st October.

Details are attached, together with a registration form.

Registrations close 3pm Friday 20th October.

Primary schools are invited to enter teams in three separate age-group hockey competitions running for 6 weeks in Term 4.

These competitions are designed to improve the skills of young hockey players through quality coaching as well as instruction during games. This will set them up well if they wish to join a local hockey club next season.

First-Sticks for Year 3/4 Students

Fridays 4pm - 7pm @ Dudley Park Multi-Sport Turf

A hockey skills programme incorporating a team coaching session followed by an instruction-based game.

- Sessions are run by experienced local hockey coaches
- Each session is 35 min - approx 10 minutes of coaching followed by a 20 minute game
- Some rules are adapted to suit players' skill levels and encourage open play
- 6 weeks in Term 4 (3rd November to 8th December 2017)
- This competition is restricted to 8 teams

Cost \$30/player. Maximum of 8 players per team

Year 5/6 & Year 7/8 Hockey Competitions

Tuesdays 4:00-6pm @ Waimakariri Hockey Turf

Six-a-side hockey competitions for Year 5/6 and Year 7/8 students.

- Each session is 30 minutes (15 minutes per half)
- 6 weeks in Term 4 (31st October to 5th December 2017)
- This competition is restricted to 16 teams across both age groups. Depending on team numbers there may be cross over games between age-groups
- Games played at Waimakariri Hockey Turf on Coldstream Road, Rangiora

Mouthguards and shin pads are compulsory for all players.


