Feedback from the Home & School Survey

Hi everyone, thank you to the half of school families who completed our 5 question parent survey. Of those families, approximately half said they would rather pay a donation to Home & School for the extra items the NLS budget can't cover, than contribute time to fund raising. This was valuable information for us, but because that still only represents a quarter of our families, we can't really make a change in that direction. So, this means that fund raising for our children will continue as it has been in the past. With this in mind, we would like to let you all know the purpose and calendar for Home & School so that as many of you as possible contribute some time to fund raising and it doesn't fall on the shoulders of a few parents.

Home & School (sometimes referred to in other schools as the PTA) is a voluntary group of parents and a teacher liaison who aim to raise a minimum of \$10,000 per year of extra funds for items our school can't afford. This enables the school to gain resources that enrich our children's education without approaching parents for extra funds. These items vary from year to year, but have included sports equipment, an oven for the hall so Garden to Table can operate well, computer equipment and kapa haka uniforms.

We also aim to run some events each year that don't specifically raise money but bring the school together and foster a sense of community among the families. These include the winter lunches, the school disco & movie nights, Easter egg hunts, and BBQ's that are run during school events. We usually plan a wide variety of fund raising activities, as often as possible gathering money from outside our community to lighten the financial burden on our own families. These events include the Fun Run in September, this year the Trail Ride in May and raffles and sales of eco-friendly items where a portion of sales goes to school.

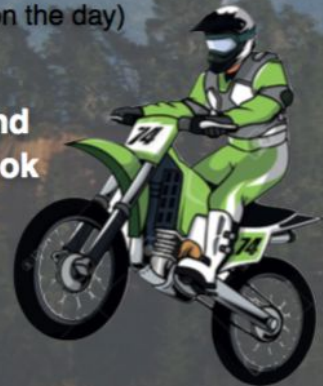

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
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
