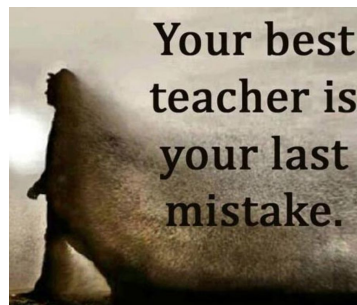

## ***Mindsets change the meaning of failure***

This week I was reading a little bit more about Growth Mindset in a book written by Dr Carol Dweck and I came across this section. I thought it would be a good starting point for this week's newsletter.

A New York Times article pointed out that failure has been transformed from an action (I failed) to an identity (I am a failure). This is especially true in the fixed mindset. Ernie Els, the great golfer worried about being considered a failure. He finally won a tournament after a five year dry spell, in which match after match had slipped away from him. What if he had lost this tournament, too? He said "I would have been a different person, I would have been a loser!" For many this asks the question - *why should we take risks, or put ourselves in a situation where we can fail?*

Failure can be a painful experience, even in the growth mindset. But the most important thing is that it does not define you. It's a problem to be faced, dealt with and learnt from. We can empower ourselves by taking control of it. In doing so we are using the experience to better ourselves. We can stay in 'the process by learning from our mistakes'.

Our challenge as educators and parents is to continue to encourage our children to take risks in their learning, to give new things a go, to know that failure is okay and to empower them to learn from these and be better for them.

# Day Old Chickens

Day old pullet (female brown shavers) chickens, from Southern Chicks, Ohoka, will be delivered on approx 18<sup>th</sup> September we will confirm date by phone, at a cost of \$4.60 per bird for Students families and \$5.75 per bird for non school familes. Rearing your chicks

1. Before your chicks arrive make sure that you have somewhere to rear them. This must be clean, dry, warm, free from draughts and safe from animals (ferrets, cats and dogs).
2. The optimum temperature is 35°C reducing this by two to three degrees each week. At six weeks your chicks can do without artificial heat.
3. Heat can be provided by an infra-red light (lamb rearing light) or by an ordinary light bulb of 25 to 40 watts suspended 20 to 30 centimetres above the chickens.
4. The chickens let you know how they are feeling by their behaviour. If they huddle together or/and cheep loudly they are too cold.
5. Food- "Chick Pex" available from the Rangiora New World supermarket in 2 kg bags or from The Feed Shack, Newnham Street, Rangiora. They will eat approximately 1 kg per chicken before they go on to "Grower Pellets" at 6 to 8 weeks.
6. Water- the chicks need a fresh supply of water available to them at all times. It should not be too cold. Make sure they know how to get a drink by gently dipping their beaks in the water when they first arrive.
7. It is best to have food and water available at all times. Self-feeding hoppers can be made from an inverted tin or plastic bottle with a hole low on the side, in a dish or cut down ice-cream container.
8. In the past we have been advised by the hatchery to keep the chickens in the dark for the first 12-24 hours to allow their eyes to mature. Keeping them in a cardboard box in the hot-water cupboard is suitable, but it is very important that they are kept warm enough at this stage. If your cupboard is not warm enough (35°C) put them straight under the warming light.
9. The chicks need to be kept warm day and night for approximately four weeks. At this stage they can be put outside on warm days as long as they are safe from cats and dogs. They will need to be put back under their light/heater at night. At 6 weeks they can be left outside night and day with protection from cold, rain, and animals (ferrets, cats and dogs). Straw and hay can keep them warm for the first few nights, or at this stage you may need to teach them to perch by lifting them up on to perches at dusk.

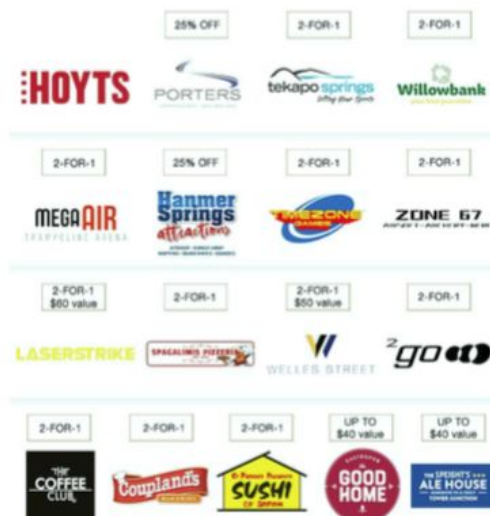


