- The ARTS build confidence because it allows children to feel pride in his or her original artistic creations or performances.


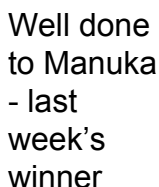

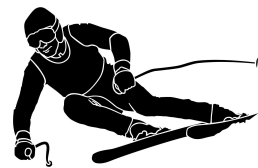

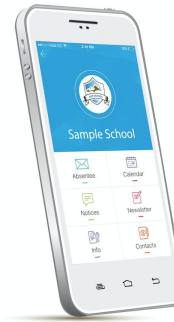
