Why is Teaching Children Empathy Important?

Kia Ora whānau,

One of the publications that we receive at school is called 'Teachers Matter'. In the latest one there was a good article on *developing empathy with our children*. We know that empathy is the ability to put yourself in the shoes of someone else and to understand what they are feeling or experiencing. Research also tells us that in the early years of life, younger children are naturally ego-centric and are very much inclined to think mostly about themselves and their own immediate needs. They are not ready to really consider the needs and feelings of others.

So what are the benefits of having a strong sense of empathy?

1. It helps our children build a sense of security and stronger relationships with other children.
2. It encourages tolerance and the willingness to accept others for who they are.
3. Promotion of good mental health
4. The promotion of a greater sense of social harmony.

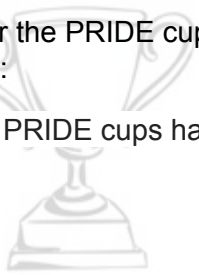
The challenge for us as parents first, and then as educators, is to help our tamariki build an understanding of what others are feeling, develop an awareness that their own actions can impact on others and to be able to understand that others may be experiencing different feelings at a particular time. If we are able to teach them how to be empathetic then we are gifting them with a great life skill.


