This is a mammoth task that takes many months of planning and organising. While the weather threatened to spoil the day, it did work out alright in the end. ## CoL update - Teacher Only Day (Thursday 16th November)

The official CoL launch for all 17 schools will be taking place on Thursday 16th November. This is the day before Show Weekend. Please note that this will be a **Teacher Only Day**. This teacher only day is the same for all schools in the CoL. This will be the first time where all of the staff from the 17 schools in the CoL will come together.



In terms of the CoL work within our school, we are continuing to focus our discussions around the achievement targets and what we can be doing to assist our students. This week all of the teachers will be taking 45 minutes out of their classroom (either Tuesday or Wednesday) and using that time to observe in one of the other classrooms in the school. A reliever will be used to cover each room while the teacher is out observing. This is a new initiative for us this year and is one we are looking forward to trialing. The staff will then meet after these observation meetings to share what we saw in the classrooms.

Last week we also met two of the Across School leaders who have been appointed for our CoL. Sue Graham, whom many of you will have heard of from her work here with us, and Felicity Upjohn from Swannanoa. A third leader has been appointed from Rangiora High School and it is hoped another 3 will be appointed. These leaders will be working across all of the schools and working alongside the teachers to support them.


