### **Celebrating Māori language week.**

Ngā mihi nui ki a koutou katoa. Greetings to you all.

This week is an important week as it is Māori language week. Kia ora te reo Māori is the theme for this year's Māori Language week. The theme for this year was chosen to celebrate New Zealand's indigenous greeting.

Te Reo Māori is a taonga recognised under the Treaty of Waitangi, a primary source of our nation's self-knowledge and identity, and an official language. By understanding and using te reo Māori, New Zealanders become more aware of the role played by the indigenous language and culture in defining and asserting our point of difference in the wider world. (*New Zealand Curriculum, pg 14*)

Our own school curriculum states the following:

- We are a values based school, and therefore, Tikanga should be incorporated into our teaching and learning experiences.
- The knowledge and expertise of our Māori community needs to be acknowledged and reflected in our school culture.

Our school charter also supports the teaching of te reo Māori through strategic goals that are written around Quality Cultural Awareness. We are fully aware that there are numerous teaching and learning opportunities for us to reflect on with regard to traditional tikanga (protocol) relevant to our own district.

We are looking forward to celebrating Māori Language week with you all.

## Enviro-spot -Ranger Leary

### BEANS FOR BEEF 2

I got a lot of good feedback for Beans for Beef and a lot of people asked for some recipes, so here's one of my favourite recipes.

### INGREDIENTS

- 1 tablespoon oil
- 1 large brown onion, finely chopped
- 1 capsicum, diced
- Half can of corn
- 1 can diced tomatoes in juice (mexican flavour)
- 1 can of red kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 x 220g packet plain corn chips
- 1 cup grated tasty cheese
- 1/2 avocado, peeled, cored
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- Sour Cream



### METHOD

- Heat oil in a large heavy-based frying pan over medium-high heat. Add onion and cook, stirring, for 2 to 3 minutes or until onion is tender.
- Add capsicum, corn, tomatoes, beans. Season with salt and pepper. Bring to the boil. Reduce heat to medium and simmer for 20 to 25 minutes, or until vegetables are tender and beans are heated through
- Preheat oven to 200°C. Arrange corn chips on heatproof serving plates. Sprinkle with half of the cheese. Spoon over bean mixture. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Bake for 10 minutes or until corn chips are crisp and cheese is melted.
- Place avocado into a bowl. Add lemon juice and mash. Dollop over dish and serve with sour cream.


