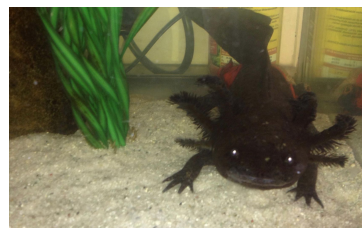
## Axolotl


