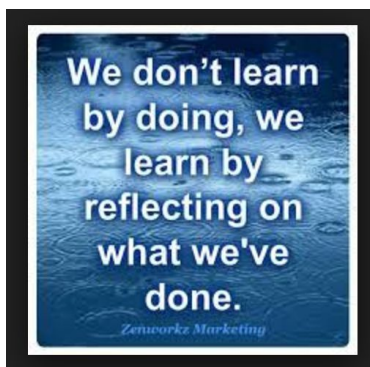

### **Week 9**

The production is finally here. Please remember that we have the 4 performances this week and that the matinee starts at 10am.

- Tuesday morning 19th September (Matinee for grandparents and preschoolers **starting at 10am**)

- Wednesday evening 20th September (6pm) and
- Thursday evening 21st September (6pm).

After the matinee we are offering parents the opportunity to collect their children and take them home for a rest before coming back for the evening. We appreciate this may not work for everyone. If you are able to collect your child (approximately 12:30pm) then please ensure that you have informed your child's teacher. This will ensure we can let the bus know.

We will have an optional late start (11am) on the Friday morning to help our students cope with two late nights. We also appreciate that some parents may chose to keep their children at home and bring them in later each morning after the performances to allow them to rest. We would ask that you please contact your child's teacher to inform them of this arrangement. We would still like all children here by 11am. **A reminder that the evening shows are not suitable for preschool children.** We want to give our students the chance to shine on the stage without distractions and our audience to watch the performance uninterrupted. The Tuesday matinee show is ideal for preschoolers to attend.

*For the evening performances we would like all the children at school by 5:30pm. They are to go to their classroom. They will then be taken to the hall at 5:55pm. At the completion of each show the children will move back to their classroom. This is where you will be able to collect them.*

## Dates for the 2018 School Year

At our last Board of Trustees meeting we confirmed the dates for the **2018 school year**. The staff will begin the school year on **Monday 29th January** as a Teacher Only Day. The children will then come back to school on **Tuesday 30th January**. We have been asked to keep a Teacher Only Day up our sleeve for use with the CoL. We have also put a Teacher Only Day in for **15th November**, the day before show weekend. The final day for the year will be **Tuesday 18th December**.

The actual term start dates and holidays are shown below:

### Term 1

T.O.D 29th January (staff only), Children start on 30th January and term ends 13th April  
Holidays = Waitangi Day (6th Feb), Easter Friday (30th March), Easter Monday (2nd April)

### Term 2

Starts 30th April and finishes on Friday 6th July  
Holidays = Queen's birthday 4th June

### Term 3

Starts 23rd July and finishes on Friday 28th September

### Term 4

Starts on Monday 15th October and finishes on Tuesday 18th December  
Teacher Only Day - Thursday 15th November  
Holidays = Labour day (22nd October), Canterbury Show Day (Friday 16th November)

# 2017 Term 4 Monday Twilight School Football Competition

The competition will begin on **Monday 30<sup>th</sup> October**, and run for 6 weeks, finishing on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December.

Subject to entries, games will be played between 3:45pm and 6pm with three kick off times (3:45pm, 4:30pm and 5:15pm).

Games will be held at Maria Andrews Park in Rangiora.

As with Term 1 we have given schools the option to play Year 4's in either a new Yr 3 & 4 comp or Yr 4-6 comp, and the Year 6's in either the Yr 4-6 or Yr 6-8 comp. We hope this provides sufficient flexibility.

The last three terms we haven't had sufficient numbers for girls only leagues. The response from most schools with regard girls, is that they are happy to play in mixed competitions, rather than girls only. But should you want to enter girls only teams, that is fine.

There will be 4 sections as follows:

Year 0, 1 & 2 – playing 5-a-side, max of 8 players per team – ½ junior pitch

Year 3 & 4 – playing 5-a-side, max of 8 players per team – ½ junior pitch

Year 4, 5 & 6 – playing 7-a-side, max of 10 players per team – junior pitch

Year 6, 7, & 8 – playing 9-a-side, max of 12 players per team – intermediate pitch

**Entry fees will remain at the same level for 2017 per team (GST inclusive):**

Year 0,1,2 teams \$100

Year 3,4 teams \$100

Year 4-6 teams \$125

Year 6-8 teams \$150

Schools will be invoiced in the first 2 weeks of the competition.

Players are asked to wear shin pads as these are compulsory under FIFA laws.

Once again we will have prizepacks up for grabs for winning schools to support football and sport in your school.

Each team will require a manager to co-ordinate the team.

An email address and contact mobile number for this person would be helpful to ensure updates to draws or cancellations are communicated with teams.

We will again have the support of our WUFC youth players to referee matches.

We look forward to receiving your entries.

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
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
